Dear Parent/Carer and Pupil

You may know that Suffolk County Council (SCC) have a Post-16 Travel Policy which may support Post-16 students to travel to and from their nearest school sixth form or their nearest college when they meet the distance criteria.

The proposed Post-16 Travel Policy Statement for the 2020/2021 school can be found at www.suffolk.gov.uk/consultations. This will be considered by the SCC Cabinet at its meeting on 21 April 2020 and the agreed policy will be published on www.suffolkonboard.com/schooltravel.

The policy is for full-time learners aged 16-18 and those aged 19 and over, if they are continuing a defined learning programme with agreed outcomes, started before their 19th birthday. It also provides the policy for continuing learners with Education, Health and Care Plans aged 19-25.

Young people need to plan their journeys when thinking about their Post-16 pathways and should read the policy to understand whether they are eligible for subsidised Post-16 travel. It is important that families and young people start considering and planning their journey to the school or college or apprenticeship now. Use Suffolk on Board Journey Planner and route lists to help you www.suffolkonboard.com/planner. There are also many sustainable travel options and often local bus or train services can offer cheaper/ discounted ticket options for students than SCC's subsidised travel.

There is lots of useful information provided on www.suffolkonboard.com such as what transport colleges and schools are putting on for their students and information about applying for a free Endeavour Card. The Endeavour Card is accepted by many bus operators, gives young people at least a 25% discount on their travel and can be used at weekends, in the evening or during school holidays too.

If young people believe that they are entitled to subsidised travel, they need to apply **before the closing date of 31 May 2020**. They should apply for their travel for September 2020 between **1 April and 31 May 2020** on www.suffolkonboard.com/apply. If an alternative course is secured after 31 May 2020, please let us know as soon as possible.
